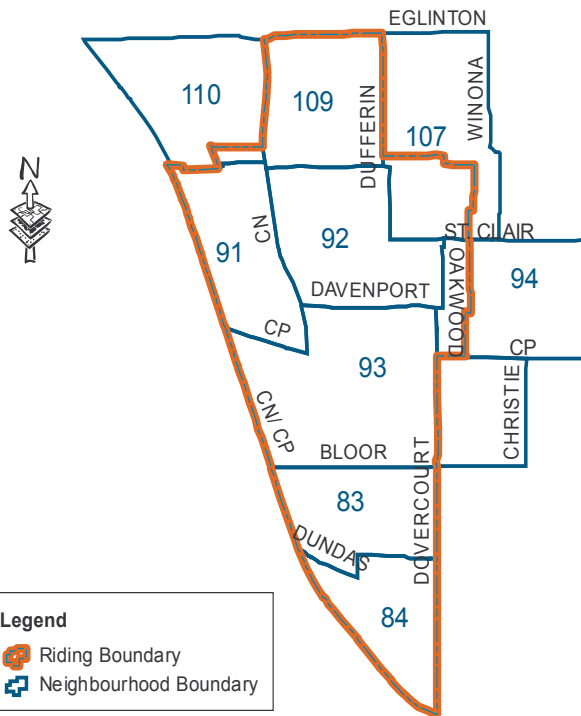

Davenport Neighbourhoods

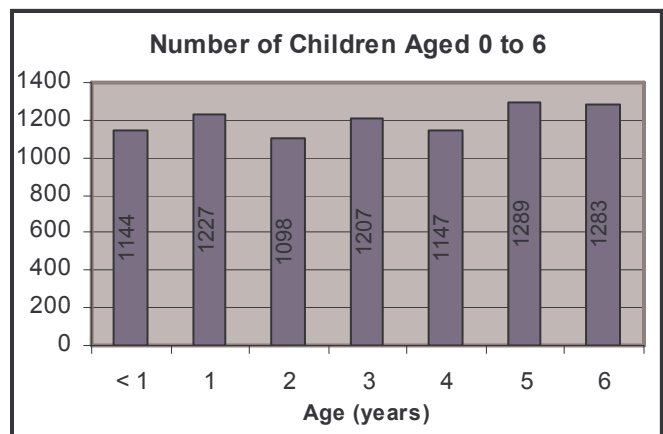

- ◆ Less than one-tenth (8%) of the population is aged 0 to 6.

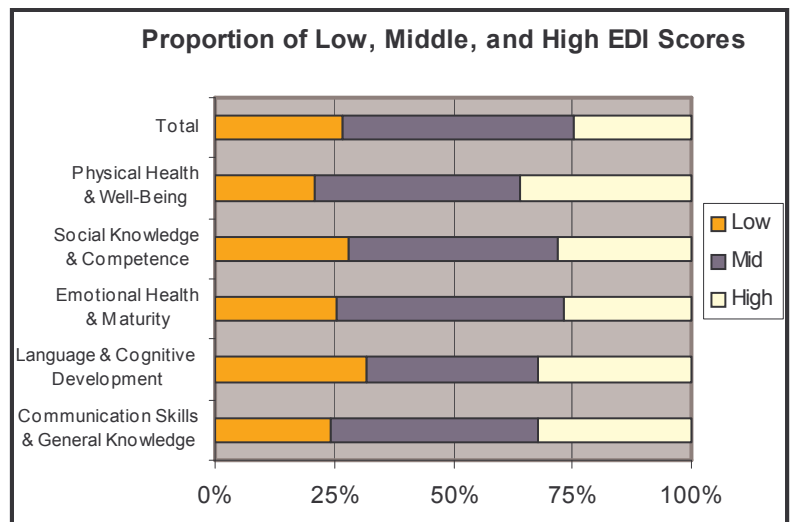

- ◆ The proportion of low-, middle- and high-scoring children in the riding are distributed as follows:



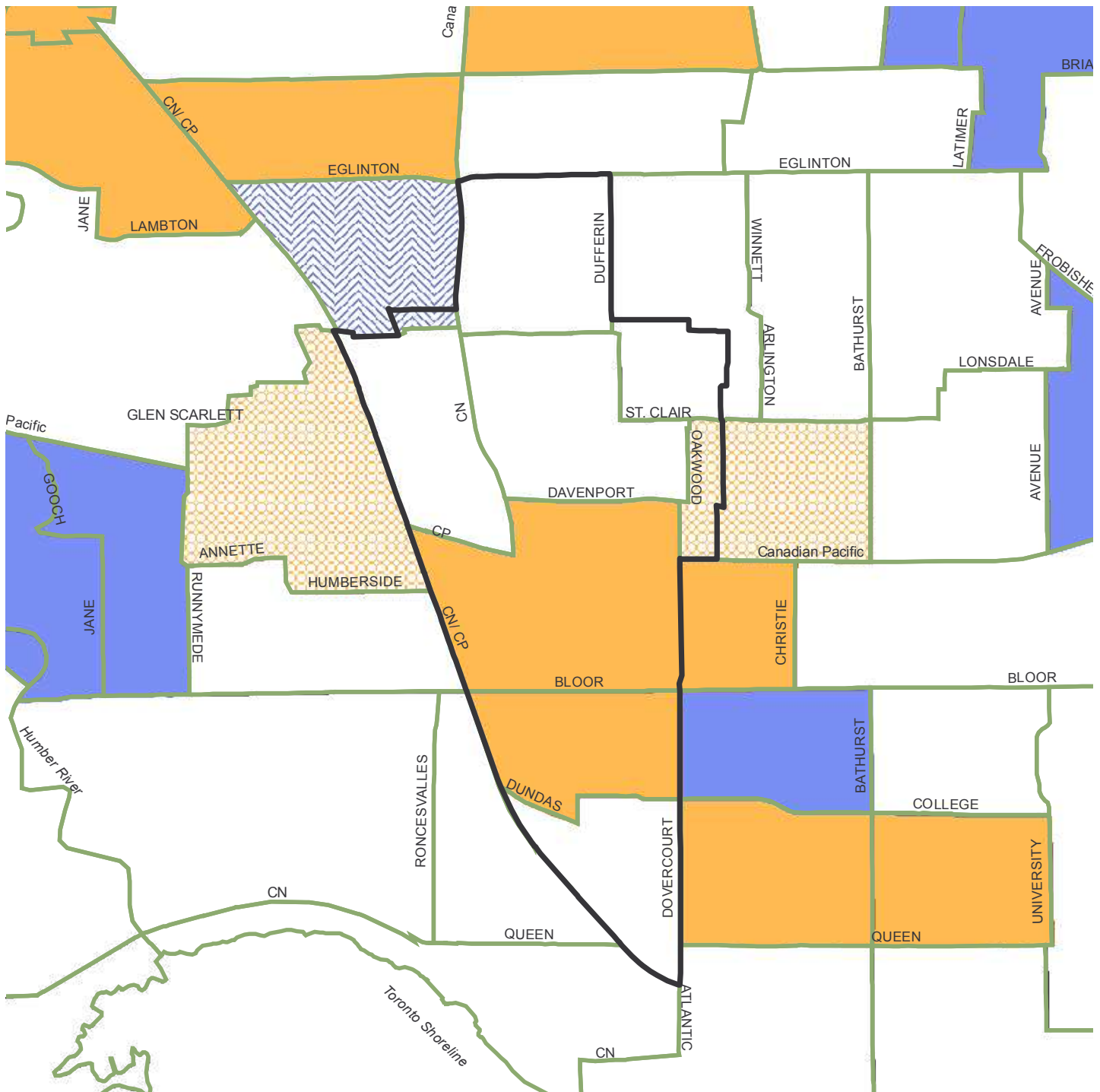

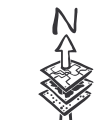
